## About the **NEW MEES** Sexuality Program Teacher's Tool Box

### Who is this Tool Box for?

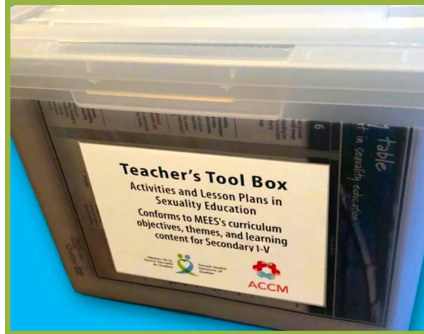
Anybody delivering Sexuality Education in schools, including nurses, teachers, and any other education professionals.

### What is Inside this Tool Box?

The Tool Box contains complete activity kits (including materials, sample questions, props and laminated resources) ready to be used in compliance with the MEES curriculum.

### What is the Cost?

The Tool Box costs \$1800. The box includes 19 fully laminated reusable activity kits including answer keys, notes to instructors, games and facilitation tools. Broken down, this cost comes to only \$75 per theme. The tool box can be used year after year, in classroom after classroom.



### Do You Need Training to use the Tool Box?

While training is always preferred, the Tool Box comes ready to be used by anyone who will be teaching Sexuality Education.

### Is the Tool Box really conformed to MEES?

Yes! This Tool Box is specifically designed to fit the MEES curriculum, meaning that you will have activity kits that are arranged by grade level requirements, rather than by topic.

### Is the Tool Box Translated into French?

Yes! Teacher's Tool Boxes are available in both French and English.

### Is this Tool Box for both Elementary and High School Sexual Education?

The Tool Box is designed to meet the requirements of the MEES curriculum for Secondary Education 1-5.

### Aren't there Free Resources available Online?

While there are other materials available online, the Teacher's Tool Box is designed to be a one-stop shop for all teachers to deliver the full MEES Sexuality Program for Secondary levels. It includes activity kits, additional lesson plans, safer sex materials, and additional resources for teachers, separated by grade and subject, all in one box!
